Region / Municipality	10 Examples of Quick wins from Accountability mechanism Q4 FY2I
HAUTE MATSIATRA / ANDRANOVORIVATO	<p>Communities requested transparency of commune revenues and expenses during community meetings following announcement of tax recovery at the local level.</p> <p>Result: The Commune is posting tax revenues and related expenses at its office to ensure transparency in commune financial management</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / ANDRANOVORIVATO	<p>Community members, bothered by sudden water cuts, made a request during a meeting between communities, the Commune and the water manager.</p> <p>Result: The water manager warns water users in the event of cuts, an improvement brought to the local service.</p>
AMORON'I MANIA / AMBATOMARINA	<p>During a public hearing session in the presence of the Mayor, STEAH, Chiefs of Fokontany, SLC and local WASH committee, community members complained about the unhealthy state of the commune market.</p> <p>Result: Community cleanup and regular cleaning of the commune market.</p>
ATSINANANA / MANGABE	<p>Community members claimed better management of water resources as there is no separation of human from animal use of local rivers.</p> <p>Result: OSCEAH advocated to commune executives to take initiatives for preserving water cleanliness and harmonized use of river water. The Commune passed a hygiene code with fines for trespassers. The Code and relevant fines are posted for public information.</p>
VAKINANKARATRA / AMBOHIDRANANDRIANA	<p>The community, the Commune, and the ATEAH undertook a Community Score Card to improve the quality of water services through the rehabilitation of the existing water system.</p> <p>Result: The Commune paid for the rehabilitation of the system to make it operational.</p>

AMORON'I MANIA / AMBOHIPEROVOANA	<p>The community and the Commune conducted consultation in order to find joint solutions to improve the quality of the existing unprotected water source.</p> <p>Result: This source now provides clean water to the communities after protection measures and improvement were made by the Commune.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / ANDRANOVORIVATO	<p>The community, commune authorities and the drinking water manager conducted community meetings to reflect on how to increase water beneficiaries.</p> <p>Result: the enterprise started to offer payment in instalments, thereby giving rise to 19 new household connections.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / AMBALAVAO NAMOLY	<p>During community meeting, members expressed the need to rehabilitate a bridge.</p> <p>Result: The Commune OSCEAH and the accountability mechanism committee conducted advocacy to the commune officials, who paid for the rehabilitation of such bridge using collected tax revenues.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / ANDRAINJATO CENTRE	<p>One concern voiced in the suggestion boxes was the open defecation at the cow market and the soccer field of the commune.</p> <p>Result: OSCEAH and Chiefs of Fokontany advocated to the commune for the construction of latrines at these two locations.</p>
VATOVAVY FITOVINANY / AMBORONDRA	<p>RANO WASH conducted a training of the Commune level WASH-CSO on accountability mechanism, which led the CSO to claim transparency and sharing of information to the public.</p> <p>Result: The Commune setup a board for posting all relevant information.</p>

ALAOTRA MANGORO / AMPASIKELY	<p>The Commune level WASH-CSO advocated to the Mayor for the improvement of access to clean water by building new tapstands.</p> <p>Result: 10 tapstands are currently under construction and are funded by the Commune.</p>
AMORON'I MANIA / SAHAMADIO	<p>The Commune level WASH-CSO advocated to the Mayor and the ATEAH about the need to take measure about the market, prone to open defecation.</p> <p>Result: The Commune mobilized resources for the construction of a public latrine at the market.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / AMBALAVAO MANAMISOA	<p>The Commune level WASH-CSO advocated for the creation of VSLA group to increase access to local WASH products.</p> <p>Result: A village agent was trained and led the creation of 20 VSLA groups.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / VOHIBATO VINANITELO	<p>The Commune level WASH-CSO advocated for the creation of VSLA group to increase access to WASH and improve the living standards of the local population.</p> <p>Result: A village agent was trained and led the creation of 33 VSLA groups.</p>
VATOVAVY FITOVINANY /BEKATRA	<p>The Commune level WASH-CSO, SLC, Commune, technically supported by the regional RANO WASH team, conducted advocacy to the Commune to take measures for ensuring the cleanliness of the town and motivated the Commune to participate in the Commune Madio competition.</p> <p>Result: Construction of sanitary block and setup of garbage bins at the market. Setting of a WASH budget of 1 170 000 MGA to cover the salaries of ATEAH and cleaners, the rehabilitation of a tapstand at the Basic Health Center in Bekatra.</p>
VAKINANKARATRA / ANDRANOMAFANA	<p>The Commune level WASH CSO, in collaboration with the ATEAH conducted advocacy towards a local association for the rehabilitation of 3 tapstands subject to frequent water cuts.</p> <p>Result: The association accepted to pay for the rehabilitation of 3 tapstands in the 3 villages and the ATEAH diagnosed the reason for the frequent water cuts. The tapstands at Antsira 1, Antsira 2 and Ampamaho are now operational on a full-time basis.</p>

Region / Municipalities	9 examples of Success from the dialogue within SLC (local structure of dialogue) during Q4 /FY21
ALAO TRA MANGORO / AMPARAFARAVOLA	<p>The SLC conducted a public consultation where the need for garbage bins in public locations emerged.</p> <p>Result : 2 garbage bins were setup at the market, 1 at the bus station and 1 near the BNI Bank, preventing the spread of garbage.</p>
AMORON'I MANIA / AMBATOFITORAHANA	<p>The SLC conducted a consultation where the need for a garbage dump emerged.</p> <p>Result: A garbage dump was built in the town centre to prevent spread of filth.</p>
AMORON'I MANIA / AMBOSITRA 2	<p>After being strengthened by the RANOWASH TA, the SLC conducted a public consultation on how to combat open defecation.</p> <p>Result : Communities are convinced and built family latrines, showers and are increasingly using SanPlat slabs.</p>
ATSINANANA / ANDONDABE	<p>The SLC was strengthened by RANO WASH on its roles and responsibilities.</p> <p>Result: The Commune no longer makes a decision on their own without consulting this structure, thereby ensuring better balance of power between the Commune and the population.</p>
ATSINANANA / SAHAMBALA	<p>The SLC and WASH-CSO advocated to the Mayor that the Commune should be ODF.</p> <p>Result: The Mayor is leading the institutional triggering of chiefs of fokontany and all other local stakeholders to launch the ODF Commune process.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / AMBALAVAO SENDRISOA	<p>The SLC proposed for the High School to have sanitation facilities.</p> <p>Result: The SLC, in collaboration with the Commune and the regional RANOWASH SOI officer, triggered the responsible of the high school, leading to the construction of latrines at this institution.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / AMBALAVAO KIRANO	<p>The SLC were trained on fiscalty and conducted consultations on the need to setup and use a WASH budget.</p> <p>Result: A budget of 7 000 000 Ariary was setup for FY21, with over 2 106 700 Ariary spent as of the reporting period.</p>

HAUTE MATSIATRA / LALANGINA ANDRAINJATO	<p>The SLC proposed the improvement of an unprotected source to the Commune.</p> <p>Result : The Commune has taken measures to protect this source.</p>
VATOVAVY FITOVINANY / AMBOANJO	<p>In order to have reliable data, the SLC proposed a census of the population by the chiefs of fokontany.</p> <p>Result: The Commune now has reliable data for updating SE&AM.</p>

AMORON'I MANIA / ILAKA CENTRE	<p>The Commune built/rehabilitated a facility with one shower and three latrine compartments at the Secondary School of Ilaka Centre</p>
AMORON'I MANIA / ALAKAMISY AMBOHIMHAZO	<p>AMBALAGNARY is self-declared ODF following efforts on behalf of the Mayor, the ATEAH, chiefs of Fokontany and the local WASH committee</p>
AMORON'I MANIA / ANKAZOAMBO	<p>The Commune rehabilitated a facility composed of 2 shower and 2 latrine compartments at the Basic Health Centre of ANKAZOAMBO CSB, STEAH, KRFF Maire, ML, STEAH, Chef CSB, Staff DRS</p>
VAKINAKARATRA/ AMBATOLAHY	<p>The Commune mobilized data collectors to each hamlet to develop their PCDEAH (400,000 Ar)</p>
ATSINANANA / AMPOROFORO	<p>A WASH budget was setup and is funding the SLC meetings and consultations and the salaries of the STEAH (including SE&AM update and implementation of the PCDEAH). 95 % of the communities are using improved latrines. The SLC is opening the eyes of the Commune on its current situation and is causing the Mayor and his team to take initiatives to improve WASH, such as institutional triggering and consultations.</p>
HAUTE MATSIATRA / AMBALAVAO ANDRAINJATO	<p>This Commune is now ODF following the institutional triggering conducted by local stakeholders, such as the Mayor's team, Chiefs of Fokontany, OSCEAH, WASH committees and SLC.</p> <p>The Commune built 10 institutional latrines at primary and secondary schools as well as throughout the Commune.</p>

Regions / Municipalities	10 Examples of Quick Win by Commune team during Q4 FY21
HAUTE MATSIATRA / AMBALAVAO MANAMISOA	The Commune, in collaboration with the TA, ATEAH, WASH committee, villagers' association and OSCEAH, are monitoring CLTS activities, which have led to use of improved latrines by 75% of the population
VATOVAVY FITOVINANY / MANAKARA AMBANDRIKA	The STEAH was trained and was able to fix a handpump facility in Nanarena village
VAKINANKARATRA / ANDRANOMANELATRA	The Commune managed to increase by 38% its tax collection rate, which was returned back to communities for the rehabilitation of the Public Primary Schools of Fandrindrano and Andranomanelatra, as well as the roofing of the basic health center.
VAKINANKARATRA / ANTSOSO	The Commune managed to increase by 30% its tax collection rate following RANO WASH support and follow-up and implementation of tax collection strategies.
