

## ANNEX 18. QUICK WINS FROM THE LOCAL STRUCTURES Q1.23

Municipality / Region	Examples of Quick win from Accountability Mechanisms
<b>TANAMBE / ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	<p>Communities complained through suggestion boxes that the water from the supply system was turbid and colored.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune requested Institut Pasteur to come and conduct water quality test, which results remain to be received.</p>
<b>ILAKA EST / AT SINANANA</b>	<p>Communities requested the reforestation of the watershed around the water source in the commune.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune ordered young trees from SEFONALA and invited the water user associations to help plant them and they responded positively.</p>
<b>BEFORONA / ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	<p>Complaints were received from suggestion boxes on the turbidity of consumption water in the commune</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune requested ACOGEMA to speed up the construction work on the water reservoir, whose construction is reaching its final stage now.</p>
<b>AMPASIMADINIKA / AT SINANANA</b>	<p>The local water manager complained about the existence of E-coli in the water when tested.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune identified 11 fish breeding ponds upstream of the catchment facility and convened all stakeholders such as the department of fisheries, agriculture, DREAH, the owners to raise the issue. It was then agreed that DREAH will provide an estimate for an infrastructure to treat the water from these fish breeding ponds, half of which will be paid by the Commune and half by the owners.</p>
<b>MAHASOABE / VATOVAVY FITOVINANY</b>	<p>Communities during their meeting request for support as household latrines keep collapsing due to heavy rainfall associated with cyclones.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> Although the commune cannot provide material or financial support, they have conducted sensitization to households on the importance of prioritizing the rehabilitation of latrines.</p>

Municipality / Region	Examples of Quick win from Accountability Mechanisms
<b>KELILALINA / VATOVAVY FITOVINANY</b>	<p>Communities complained about the non-rehabilitation of the water system through community meetings</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune deliberated that they will prioritize the rehabilitation and is currently looking for the financial means to do so.</p>
<b>AMBOHIMANDROSO / VAKINANKARATRA</b>	<p>Communities complain about the non-construction of water system in the Commune.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune approached the Ministry of WASH, which recommended the sending of new requests along with the detailed information on the proposed construction.</p>
<b>ANTSOANTANY / VAKINANKARATRA</b>	<p>Some community members complained about the switch to private management of the water system in the Commune because they did not want to pay for the service.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune initiated a meeting with the water manager and the DREAH and the issue is now resolved.</p>
<b>ANDRAINJATO / HAUTE MATSIATRA</b>	<p>Communities complained about the arrival of two water bills at the same time although it was agreed that they will pay one bill every month.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune visited each fokontany to explain to the water users that the arrival of two bills was due to the delayed sending of the first bill. The population understood the situation and paid both bills.</p>

Region / Municipalities	Examples of Communal WASH-CSOs Advocacy Success
<b>AMBALAVOLO /            ATSIANANA REGION</b>	<p>WASH CSO advocated for the implementation of the Dina in the Commune and posted relevant information near each river.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Municipal Council deliberated that the Dina is now effective and people defecating in rivers will face consequences.</p>
<b>ANDODABE /            ATSIANANA REGION</b>	<p>The WASH CSO has advocated for an improvement to the current water system.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune approached the water system manager to resolve the issue.</p>
<b>FANANDRANA /            ATSIANANA REGION</b>	<p>The WASH CSO advocated for the construction of a market and a public toilet at this Marketplace.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The commune built the market which is now operational and searched for funding to build the currently operational public toilet at this marketplace.</p>
<b>AMBODILAZANA /            ATSIANANA REGION</b>	<p>The WASH CSO advocated for the rehabilitation of the road to Antsampananifito.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune, in collaboration with local actors, rehabilitated the road.</p>
<b>KIRANO / HAUTE            MATSIATRA</b>	<p>The WASH CSO advocated for the construction of water system as the population needs drinking water.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Mayor asked his technical team to explore the existing water sources and identified three potential sources and is currently seeking partnership for the construction of the future system.</p>
<b>ANDRANOMIDITRA /            HAUTE MATSIATRA</b>	<p>The WASH CSO advocated the resolution of lack of medicines at the local hospital to the Commune.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune had a meeting with the medical staff and together resolved the situation. The hospital now has sufficient medicines.</p>

Region / Municipalities	Examples of Communal WASH-CSOs Advocacy Success
<b>MANDIALAZA /            ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	<p>The WASH CSO advocated for the construction of a latrine at the Commune office</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune constructed a latrine at the Town Hall.</p>
<b>ILAKA EST /            ATSINANANA</b>	<p>The WASH CSO requested the protection of local forests around the watershed.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune met with CSO to discuss on how to achieve this. Together, they set up “No Access, Protected Area” posts and established firewalls around the area.</p>
<b>KELILALINA /            VATOVAVY            FITOVINANY</b>	<p>As many of the complaints from the community are about the non-rehabilitation of the existing water system which is not operational, the WASH CSO decided to join force with the SLC in order to advocate to the Commune the importance of this request.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune deliberated that it will prioritize the rehabilitation of the current water system and is currently searching for the financial means to do so.</p>
<b>RANOMAFANA /            VATOVAVY            FITOVINANY</b>	<p>Communities complained about the dirt and trash being thrown into the Tolongoina River.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune set up a sign stating Dina of 20,000 for people who still throw trash into the river.</p>

Region / Municipalities	Examples of Success from the dialogue within SLC (local structure of dialogue)
<b>TANAMBE / ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	<p>Consultations within SLC prioritized the cleaning of the local canal as the rainy season approaches.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune mobilized a truck, paid for its fuel and employed some local people to drain the canal.</p>
<b>ILAKA EST / ATSINANANA</b>	<p>SLC consultations recommended the Commune to build a latrine block at the bus station.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune is prioritizing this initiative and is currently looking for ways to fund this infrastructure.</p>
<b>AMPASIMADINIKA / ATSINANANA</b>	<p>Road construction to school</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune constructed roads to the primary and secondary schools.</p>
<b>KELILALINA / VATOVAVY FITOVINANY</b>	<p>Communities have complained on why the water system is still not rehabilitated. After consultations, the SLC prioritized the rehabilitation of this system.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune deliberated that they will prioritize the rehabilitation and is currently looking for the financial means to do so.</p>
<b>RANOMAFANA / VATOVAVY FITOVINANY</b>	<p>The water at the slaughterhouse of the Commune was no longer running and the SLC advocated to the Commune that this needs to be prioritized.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune rehabilitated the water connection using their WASH budget.</p>
<b>AMBOHIMANDROSO / VAKINANKARATRA</b>	<p>The SLC recognized the need to hold fundraising events in order for them to be able to finance their consultations and activities.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The Commune is aware of the importance of this structure and provided an authorization for such events after the rainy season.</p>

Region / Municipalities	Examples of Success from the dialogue within SLC (local structure of dialogue)
<b>ANDRAINJATO / HAUTE MATSIATRA</b>	SLC consultations highlighted the need to prioritize a better organization of the management of the private water system manager. <b>Result:</b> The Commune deliberated that the water manager should send monthly report to the Commune and pay commune tax every six months.
<b>ANDRANOMIDITRA / HAUTE MATSIATRA</b>	The SLC actively participated in the development of the commune budget for 2023. <b>Result:</b> Based on their recommendations, the Commune will prioritize the reaching of ODF status and waste management during the year 2023.

Regions / Municipalities	Examples of Quick Win by Commune team
<b>ANOSIBE IFODY / ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	The STEAH sensitizes each fokontany to end open defecation and 85% of the population at fokontany-level are no longer practicing open defecation.
<b>FIERENANA / ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	The STEAH and commune police conduct monthly verification of open defecation in each of the Fokontanys
<b>BEFORONA / ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	The Commune paid local people to drain the commune canals as the rainy season approaches.
<b>MANDIALAZA / ALAOTRA MANGORO</b>	The Commune decided to clean the wastewater canal, conducted ODF verifications and implemented the Dina on non-compliant people.
<b>ILAKA EST / ATSINANANA</b>	The Commune constructed a latrine block at the marketplace
<b>TSARASAOTRA / AMORON'I MANIA</b>	The Commune built a public sanitary block in the town center.
<b>AMPASIMADINIKA / ATSINANANA</b>	The Commune built a public sanitary block with a shower near the Commune office. The commune staff also decided to clean the town and the population then decided to join them.

Regions / Municipalities	Examples of Quick Win by Commune team
<b>MAHASOABE / VATOVAVY FITOVINANY</b>	The Commune decided to give SanPlat slabs to the people who are actively constructing their household latrines.
<b>RANOMAFANA / VATOVAVY FITOVINANY</b>	Water extension into the fokontany of Tsaramandroso
<b>AMBOHIMANDROSO / VAKINANKARATRA</b>	The Commune has set up 3 trash bins and built a public latrine block at the bus station of the town, the latter in collaboration with the Local Development Fund of the Ministry of Interior and Decentralization.
